

ECFC Conference Hours for CFC/CFCI Credit

ECFC conference hours are worth 150% of the hours earned at non-ECFC programs taught by CFCIs. Thus, to be qualified for the CFC exam or for CFC recertification, you must have at least 18 hours of ECFC conferences or 25 hours of non-ECFC conference credit. For CFCIs, you must have 30 hours of ECFC credit or 45 of non-ECFC hours. You are permitted to have some ECFC conference credits and some non-ECFC conference credits.

A payment of \$10 per person per hour is required for recognition of non-ECFC sessions.

Please contact the ECFC via email at David@ECFC.org to request a detail of your ECFC hours. Only credits within 36 months of your certification exam or your recertification will be recognized. The CE hours listed below are multiplied by 150% to determine your recognized ECFC CE units.
