ECFC Membership Eligibility

Industry Membership: ECFC Industry Membership is for employers directly involved in the employee benefits industry. This includes third party administrators, employee benefit plan service providers, employee benefit consultants, card processing companies and associations, insurance carriers, banks, industry software vendors, payroll processing companies, and other members of the employee benefits industry.

Plan Sponsor Membership: Plan Sponsor Membership is specifically designed for employers who offer, promote or are interested in tax-advantaged employee benefits plans. Plan Sponsors are at the heart of the employee benefits industry and provide employee benefit plans directly to their employees.

Industry & Plan Sponsor Memberships are known as Corporate-wide memberships. For these two membership types, the annual membership dues cover all employees of the Member Company or entity. Individual and Associate memberships are single person memberships and only the person enrolling for the particular membership is eligible for the member benefits.

Associate Membership: This membership option is available to individuals and entities who provide advice and ancillary services to Plan Sponsors and/or Industry Members or who are otherwise interested in the field. Associate membership includes independent insurance agents and brokers, health care practitioners, CPAs, actuaries, employee benefit lawyers, etc. *Important Note:* Individuals and entities eligible for Industry Membership or who are employed by, own or are members of such an entity, are not eligible for Associate Membership.

Individual Membership: This membership option is limited to only those individuals who are employees of state and federal government, educators, and students. *Important Note:* Individuals and entities eligible for Industry Membership or who are employed by, own or are members of such an entity, are not eligible for Individual Membership.
